

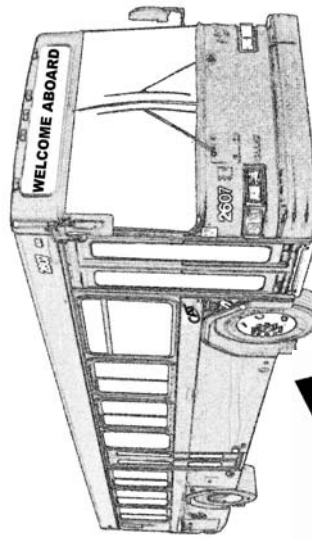

### HOW TO RIDE CAT

#### CAT FARE INFORMATION

Fares Subject to Change - Student fares K-12 only

#### BASE FARE - Exact Change Required

ZONE #1 Adult - \$1.65	Student - \$1.15
ZONE #2 Adult - \$2.05	Student - \$1.55
ZONE #3 Adult - \$2.45	Student - \$1.95

• **DAYS CAT BUSES DO NOT OPERATE:** Sundays, New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and when the Sunday Holiday is celebrated on Monday.

• **CAT** will make every effort to adhere to the published timetable but will not assume responsibility for inconvenience, expense, or missed connections resulting from inclement weather, unplanned detours, or excess traffic.

#### General Information

- Light face type on the timetable indicates AM times.
- **Bold face type on the timetable indicates PM times.**
- **HALF FARE PROGRAM:** Passengers with a disability may be entitled to a CAT issued REDUCED TRANSIT FARE card which entitles the passenger to ride the fixed route buses at half the regular adult fare. Persons with a Medicare Card qualify for this program. Senior Citizens may ride for half fare using a Medicare Card, but are encouraged to apply for the Commonwealth of PA ID card and ride for free.
- **PA SENIOR CITIZENS FREE RIDE PROGRAM:** Passengers 65 years of age and older ride free with a CAT issued Commonwealth of PA SENIOR CITIZEN ID card.
- **LOST SOMETHING ON A CAT BUS?** Articles found on a bus are kept for 30 days. Call 238-8304 if you lose an article.
- **CAN'T DO!** Smoking, drinking and eating are not permitted on CAT buses. Playing radios, televisions, compact disk players, etc. in a manner that is offensive to any passenger or driver is prohibited. No pets allowed on CAT buses, except guide and service animals.
- **CHILDREN:** Age five and under ride free when accompanied by a fare paying passenger.
