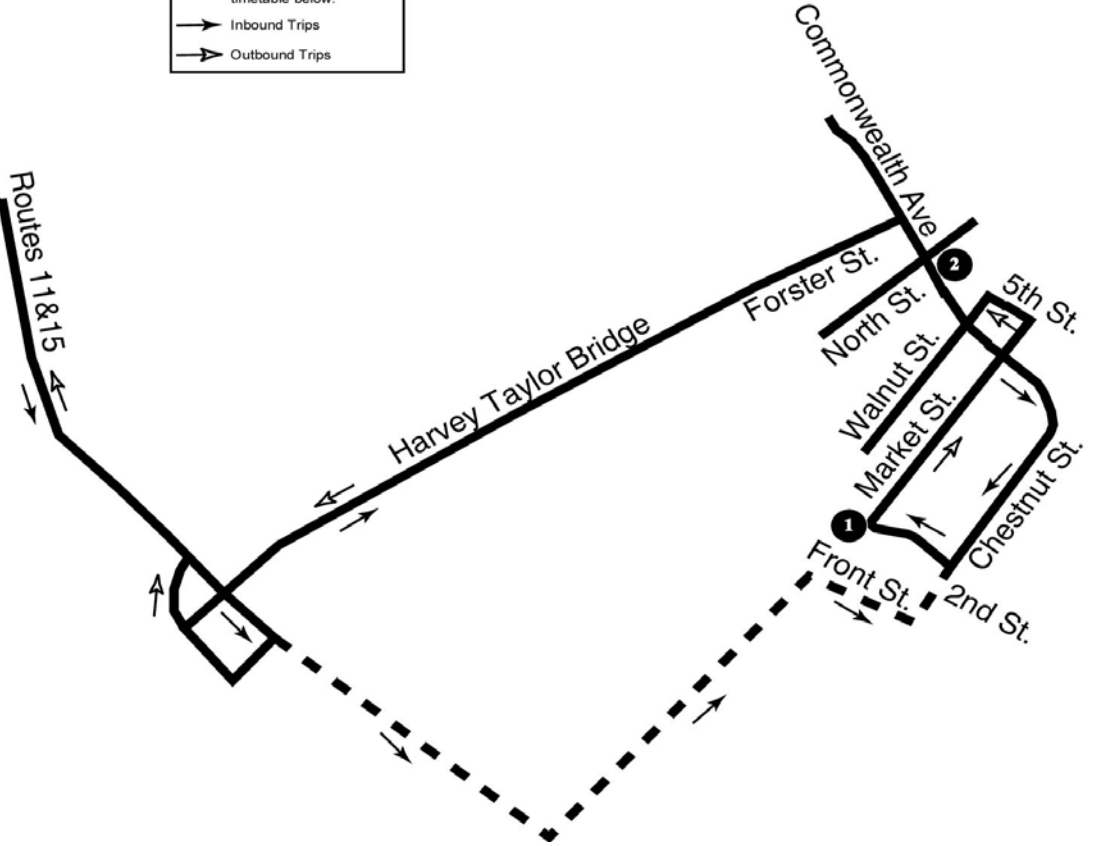




Map Not

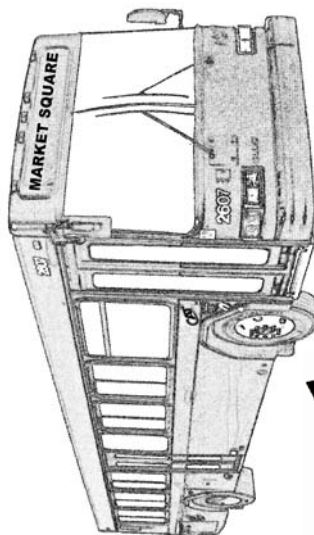

Persons with a Medicare Card qualify for this program. Senior Citizens may ride for half fare using a Medicare Card, but are encouraged to apply for the Commonwealth of PA ID card and ride for free. • PA SENIOR CITIZENS FREE RIDE PROGRAM: Passengers 65 years of age and older ride free with a CAT issued Commonwealth of PA SENIOR CITIZEN ID card. • LOST SOMETHING ON A CAT BUS? Articles found on a bus are kept for 30 days. Call 238-8304 if you lose an article. • CAN'T DO! Smoking, drinking and eating are not permitted on CAT buses. Playing radios, televisions, compact disk players, etc. in a manner that is offensive to any passenger or driver is prohibited. No pets allowed on CAT buses, except guide and service animals. • CHILDREN: Age five and under ride free when accompanied by a fare paying passenger.
