

# Driving Record Requirements

Driving records are reviewed for the following:

## Minimum requirements:

- Five years continuous, recent driving history is required (i.e. no gaps in license status)

**Any one of the following violations within the last two years or two or more in five years will result in disqualification:**

- Speeding violations (one speeding violation may be allowed if it is below 15 mph over the posted speed limit). Any speeding violation received within the last five years that is 15 or mph or more over the speed limit will result in disqualification.
- Fail/Improper signal
- Failure to stop
- No valid license
- Failure to yield the right of way
- Disobey road sign
- Following too close
- Over/straddle the center line
- Illegal overtake/pass
- Failure to appear/Failure to abide (FTA)
- Texting or cell phone violations
- Non-moving violations such as no liability insurance, no tabs, illegal or defective equipment, etc. (only one non-moving violation will be allowed if the record is otherwise clear)

**Any one of the following violations within the last five years will result in disqualification:**

- **Any** suspension (this includes suspensions relating to child support, failure to pay tickets, etc.)
- Reckless or negligent driving violations
- DWI/DUI (driving while under the influence of drugs or alcohol). No alcohol or drug related convictions within the last ten years will be accepted
- Hit and Run
- Vehicular homicide or vehicular assault
- Current probationary license status

*This list is not meant to be all inclusive. All records will be reviewed by Capital Area Transit Human Resources on an individual basis and may be cause for disqualification.*
