New Paratransit Shared Ride Fare Structure:

Effective November 4, 2019: If you are a Shared Ride Customer and ride under the Shared Ride Program for Senior Citizens or People with Disabilities (PWD) programs, this change may affect your fare.

If you are a senior citizen and your trip is for medical purposes, the Dauphin County Area Agency on Aging will continue to subsidize the fare and your portion will continue to be \$1.00.
