VETERAN TRANSPORTATION TO LEBANON VA

In partnership with Dauphin County Commissioners and Dauphin County Veterans Affairs, CAT offers Veteran Service to the Lebanon VA Medical Center.

- ❖ Service offered Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
- ❖ Reservations must be made by noon the day before (Friday for Monday appointments).
- ❖ Transportation to the Lebanon VA Medical Center is offered at NO cost to Dauphin County veterans. Riders must complete an application in advance of making a reservation.
- ❖ Shuttle departs Burger King at 3253 Paxton Street at 7:30 a.m., arrival at VA Medical Center at 8:30 a.m. Shuttle departs Lebanon VA Medical Center at 12:30 p.m. with a return to Burger King at 1:30 PM. Share-A-Ride can help with transportation to and from Burger King.
- ❖ Escorts are permitted when scheduled at time of reservation. All the vehicles are ADA accessible.

While the service is offered at no cost to the veteran, donations toward operating costs are accepted to increase transportation options for more veterans.
