Financial Statement & Statistical Notes for September 2022

- The financial statements enclosed with these notes, are as of September 30, 2022. This is the third month and the end of the first quarter of fiscal year 2023.
- ➤ The presented financial statements reflect the adopted fiscal year 2023 budget.
- ➤ The income statement includes the comparative previous fiscal year to date information.

Ridership

- Year to date comparisons to the prior year and to pre-covid levels are as follows:
 - Fixed Route ran 15% above last year and at 59 % of pre-covid ridership
 - Paratransit was 13% above the previous year and 79% of pre-covid ridership levels.
 - Commuter Express was 56% above last year (YTD) but only 34% of pre-covid levels
 - During July and August, Microtransit's, ridership was 191% above same time last year.

Revenue

Year to Date Operating Revenue is 16% or \$911 thousand higher than budget and \$1.3 million higher than same time last year.

Expenses

- Year to Date Total Expenses are \$1.8 million or 11.8 % lower than budget.
- This favorable budget variance is primarily the result of wage and associated benefit expenses being less than budgeted levels. Unfilled positions are responsible for the lower than budgeted wages. Please see the Graph of Open Positions by Division below.

Reserves

- > SRTA currently has 191 days of cash on hand.
- We have reached the Authority's target of 180 days cash on hand.

Line of Credit

There are no draws on the organization's lines of credit.

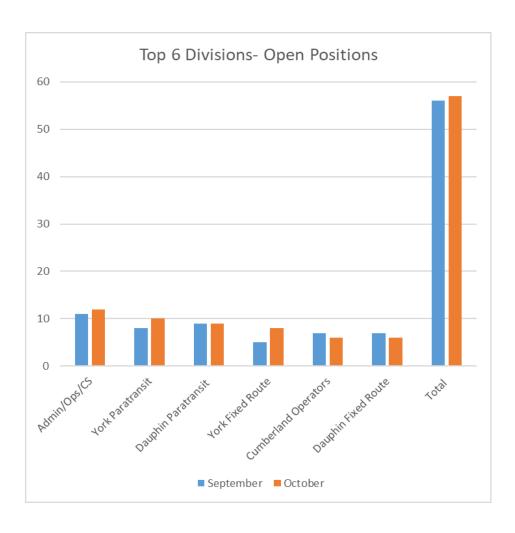
Capital Expenditures
